Incentives to create employment in your business Proposal for Fiscal Year 2012-2013

The Puerto Rico Department of Labor and Human Resources has announced the availability of wage incentive funds for the creation of employment. These incentives shall be granted to all those employers who are legally operating in Puerto Rico.

Who may participate in this course?

Any employer whose business is organized under the laws of Puerto Rico; any employer who would like to participate in an employment program for unemployed and/or displaced workers who must be registered in the Puerto Rico Department of Labor and Human Resources' Employment Service; any private entity which guarantees the retention of those employees once the incentive ends. In addition, companies that are up to date in the payment of contributions to the Unemployment, SINOT, and Chauffeurs' Social Security Programs and do not have pending debts with the Puerto Rico Department of Treasury or any other Puerto Rico government agency or those who have a pending debt and are complying with a payment plan established by the corresponding authorities. Municipalities, government agencies and not for profit organizations can also participate.
